

Luke 14: 7-14

The longer we follow Jesus, the more we realize it's not about us and our preferences. It is about how we interact and treat others because of our relationship with Jesus.

Jesus is illustrating two things in this text, humility is an essential part of faith, and our responsibility is to those who have less than we do.

Jesus makes everyone uncomfortable in the text.

Who is Jesus saying to invite to the table?

Taking a risk is part of being a follower of Jesus.

Jesus makes it clear being humble and kind is essential. How can you be humble this week?

Action Steps:

- 1. Jump into one of the summer opportunities to serve.
- 2. Pray for those around the world, in our community and our church.
- 3. Join us next week for our Unity Service at 10am.

The Community Builders (outreach) and Merciful Hands and Hearts (missions) Teams are looking for the following volunteers to help fulfill the mission of the church:

1. Sunday Morning Van Driver

Hours: 10 am - 10:30 am, 11:30 am - 12:30pm (One or multiple Sundays/month) Responsibilities:

- Pick up church-goers before services and return them afterwards.
- Assist children and those with physical challenges in embarking and disembarking the vehicle.
- · Maintain a safe and hospitable environment on the van.
- Report incidents involving passengers or equipment to the Director of Congregational Engagement immediately by completing the appropriate paperwork.
- Inspect and clean the interior of the van and lock and secure it at the end of the shift.

Requirements:

- Valid Ohio Driver's License
- Comfortable driving a 15 passenger van
- Approval from church insurance company
- Background check and Safe Sanctuary Training

Currently Mark Denniston is fulfilling this role. Having a volunteer in place will free him up to greet visitors and provide them information regarding discipleship pathway opportunities.

2. Driver Pool Participant

Periodically members of our church and community need to be transported to doctor's appointments and other critical services. We are seeking a pool of volunteers who are willing to provide transportation whenever other community resources are not available.

Hours: As needed Responsibilities:

- Transport individuals to appointments or services.
- Participants can either use their personal vehicles or the church's 15-passenger van. If using the van, above requirements apply.
- Background Check and Safe Sanctuary Training.

If you are interested in either of these opportunities, please indicate such on the sheets outside the church office. Mark Denniston will then be in contact with you to answer any questions you may have. Thank you for your prayerful consideration of this request.
