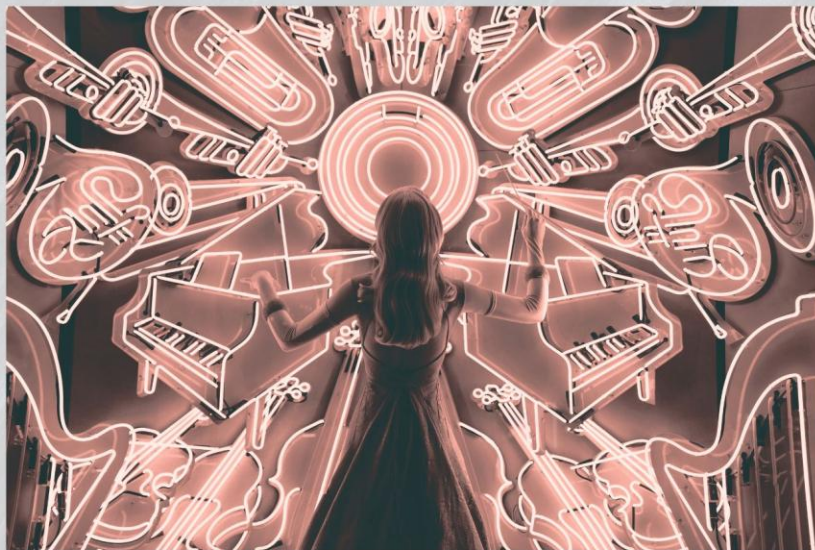

2 Timothy 3: 14-4:5
