Dear Community United Methodist Church Friends,

Grace and Peace to you this beautiful Thanksgiving Season. This season we are discovering a Wonder-full life. As we look at our histories, our patterns, Jesus' example and now our opportunities to be generous, we can see how Wonder-filled life can be. I am asking each of us in the church to take a step of faith live into the kingdom of God.

If you are just starting out in giving, I invite you to take a step of faith and begin to make a plan to give regularly. Make a commitment. We have some ways for you to do this. You can sign up for E-giving (online), or you can have your giving directly taken out of your account (direct deposit-ACH). You can also get a box of envelopes that have 52, 26, or 12 envelopes to help hold you accountable if you prefer that method.
