## 40 DAYS - 40 MILES

During the 40 days of Lent, we will focus on walking (or running!) 40 miles—about one mile each day—as a way to combine physical movement with spiritual reflection. Each day begins with reading a Bible verse that sets the tone and provides a moment of grounding. As you walk or run, you're invited to reflect on the scripture's message, how it connects to your life, and what it reveals about your faith journey. Join our Facebook support group too. By the end of Lent, the 40 miles symbolize not only physical endurance but also a deeper spiritual connection and a more intentional daily practice.
